District 7 | Collin and Grayson Counties – Inclusive of School Districts and Charter/Private schools located inside each County.

- Both Counties are currently in District 7
 - Collin County School Districts – Celina, Anna, Blue Ridge, Melissa, McKinney, Prosper, Frisco, Allen, Lovejoy, Princeton, Farmersville, Community, Wylie, Plano

District 11 | Dallas, Rockwall, Kaufman, and Ellis Counties – Inclusive of School Districts and Charter/Private schools located inside each County.

- All Current District 11 schools/Districts stay in District 11.

 - *This County was in District 6*
 - Ellis County School Districts – Ferris, Red Oak, Midlothian, Waxahachie, Maypearl, Avalon, Palmer, Ennis, Italy, Milford
 - *This County was in District 5*

NEW District 12 | Tarrant, Denton, Cooke, Montague, Wise, Parker, Hood, Johnson, Clay, Jack, Palo Pinto – Inclusive of School Districts and Charter/Private schools located inside each County.

- La Salle, McMullen, Live Oak, and Bee Counties will now be part of District 2. These were formerly part of District 1.
- Aransas, Refugio, and Calhoun Counties will now be part of District 3. These were formerly part of District 1.
- Victoria, Jackson, and Lavaca Counties will now be part of District 3. These were formerly part of District 2.

Student Leadership Opportunities

The 2024-2025 District Officer Teams will be elected at the 2024 District Conference. If a student leader from a chapter that is changing Districts is seeking to run for a District Officer position, that student may attend the District Career Development Conference that they are moving to, and apply, interview, and campaign to serve. **Students will compete in their current District for the 2023-2024 school year unless otherwise communicated.**

Chapters that are impacted may have the chapter advisor(s) and an appropriate amount of student delegates attend the 2024 CDC for the District that they will be moving to.

*Since the majority of the chapters that will form the new District 12 are currently participating in District 7, the 2024-2025 District Officer Election will take place at the District 7 CDC (January 16th, 2024), separate from the election of the new District 7 Officer Team.

Chapters will only vote as part of the election for the DECA District that they will be in for the 2024-2025 school year.

Student leaders must meet the application deadline of December 1st, 2023 to be eligible to run for any District Officer position.
