L- Let Members Know About the Opportunities

Some students may be interested in the various community service campaigns that DECA hosts each year. Promote ways for chapter members to get involved with DECA outside of competition.

Having a strong resume is important for not only college admissions but for future jobs. Let students know how much of an impact DECA can make on their professional image as they begin to think about life after high school.




There are **LIMITLESS** reasons to join DECA. Here are a few more tips on how to increase membership:

Promote your chapter's DECA shirt in order to get people interested in joining DECA.




